1. Player acknowledges and agrees that the Supplement/s listed above:
 - a) is/are not compliant with the Australian Cricket Supplement Policy (**Supplement Policy**); and
 - b) has/have not been recommended, provided or prescribed (or agreed to permit usage) to the player by an Australian Cricket Medical Officer or Australian Cricket Sports Dietician; and
 - c) is/are compliant with the WADA Anti-Doping Code and have been batch tested as required by section 9 of the Supplement Policy; and
 - d) may be used by the Player during the term of the Player's W/BBL contract in accordance with section 4.2 of the Supplement Policy, on the conditions set out in this declaration.
2. Player acknowledges and agrees that:
 - a) there is a risk that the Supplement/s may contain substances that are prohibited under the WADA Anti-Doping Code Prohibited List;
 - b) Anti-Doping Rule Violations under the WADA Anti-Doping Code, the ICC Anti-Doping Code and/or the Cricket Australia Anti-Doping Code (as relevant) may incur significant sanctions;
 - c) the Australian Cricket Supplement Panel cannot confirm the efficacy of the Supplement/s;
 - d) No AC entity (as defined in the Supplement Policy)) including but not limited to their officers, employees, volunteers, agents and contractors accepts any responsibility or liability whatsoever for any harm or damage associated with the Player's use of the Supplement/s including during the term of their W/BBL Player Contract (including any Anti-Doping Rule Violation or sanction incurred by the Player as a result of using the Supplement); and
 - e) use of the Supplement/s is at the Player's own risk.
